

1935 – Fife DA Special AGM

At a Special General Meeting held at Culross on 16th February, 1935 it was decided to make application to the Council to have area of the Fife DA extended to read: Fife District embracing the Counties of Kinross, Clackmannanshire, Fife and that part of Perthshire west of the River Tay, south of a line drawn from Perth through Methven, Gilmerton and Crieff and east of a line drawn through Muthill, Braco, Greenloaning and Dunblane to the border of Stirlingshire near Bridge of Allan, including the towns and villages on that line, and also that part of the city of Perth to the east of the River Tay. This was granted by the Council.
