## October 2019, Checkpoint Problems

		ancient monument. How many pedestrian refuges are on the north and south sides?
9 East Sussex	4 Ashdown Forest	Plaques are badly weathered. New Question at the same site: Along the B2026 at Camphill Roman Road Parking site:
		Behind the former Information Pillar and set into the turf is a metal yellow Ground Mark. What is the telephone number
		of the Survey Centre? This general area was the inspiration for A.A. Milnes Hundred Acre Wood and the Winnie the Pooh
		stories. 90 acres were burnt down in spring of 2019.

13 Berkshire	4 Walbury Hill	The weathering has been restored. Delete the note.

		fingerpost. What are the mileages to London, Norwich and Beccles?
24 Shropshire	6 Bridgnorth	Amend question to read: In Castle Terrace HIGHTOWN is the upper station of the Castlehill Cliff Railway. From the
		adjacent information board when was the railway opened and by whom?
29 Nottinghamshire	6 Nottingham	Clarification; Amend question to read: There is a statue of Robin Hood to the south (left) of the Castle
		Gatehouseetc.
32 Cheshire	1 Audlem	SITE CLOSED FOR RESTORATION WORK, which will take a considerable time, and checkpoint not accessible. Substitute
		a temporary new question: Near the Church Tower is a memorial honouring the villages dead from many conflicts. Who
		is the only person to lose their life in the Suez Conflict?
38 South Yorkshire	1 Burbage Rocks	Confusion: revised question at the same site:
		At the viewpoint, near the top of the hill between Hathersage to Ringinglow, on the south side through a pedestrian gate
		is a small wall of eleven stone blocks. How many blocks in the bottom row?
<b>41</b> County Durham	3 Bishops Aukland	Name Change – (Bishops Park has been adopted as a Housing Estate name a mile or two away) Change Bishops Park
		to read, Aukland Park
<b>44</b> Carmarthen	1 Pendine Sands	The Beach Hotel has been sold and being extensively renovated as a public house. Presently the former plaques are
		located INSIDE. What is the latest news of this checkpoint, please?
47 Montgomery	1 Montgomery	Correction: Amend 'Sarah' to 'Mary.'
<b>54</b> South Lanarkshire	6 Hamilton	Part of the question has been "lost." Amend to read: On the wall of the churchyard of Old Hamilton Parish Church main
		gateway, is a plaque. Who designed the present building?
<b>57</b> Argyll and Bute	2 Gruline	2 BETTER QUESTION: Amend to read, "There is a Mausoleum to the "Father of Australia." The FARTHEST End is sealed
		with a large white marble slab. What is the scripture verse carved on it?
	6 Helensburgh	6 Delete the note in Italics.
59 Perth and Kinross	4 Gary Bridge	Amend the question to Read, "At the WEST end of the bridge"
67 Orkney	3 Lambholm	Another statue has been added this year. Amend to read: What is the inscription on the statue of St. George and the
		Dragon, at the Italian Chapel?
