Dave M will also check availability of the St Thomas Church Hall on Thursday afternoons (after Bikebus rides) during the same period.
- Christmas lunch. Lyndsay has made a provisional booking at the Red Lion for Sunday 10 December and will contact them again to make a £250.00 deposit, to be reimbursed from club funds by Dave M. An invitation will be sent to members after the curry night has taken place.
