5-6 mile rides

Sat 3 Feb @ 2pm – 4pm

Nature Ride – Three Parks (5 miles) Join this ride to explore the hidden nature around us. We'll stop at various points to look for minibeasts and birds. All equipment provided.

Sun 11 Feb @ 10am – 12pm

History Ride – The Parks (6 miles) Discover the history of Greenbank, Sefton and Princes Parks.



10-16 mile rides

Sun 4 Feb @ 10am – 1pm

City Explorer via The Pier Head (10 miles)
The River Mersey plus cathedrals, universities and three beautiful parks all in one ride.

Sat 24 Feb @ 10am – 2pm

South Liverpool Circular (16 miles)
Explore South Liverpool on a mix of traffic free paths and residential streets. Includes the Loop Line and Otterspool Prom.

Sat 17 Feb @ 10am – 3pm

History Ride - Four Cathedrals of Liverpool (21 miles)
We'll encounter four "cathedrals" which have played a part in the social history of Liverpool. Cycle into the city centre, then to Anfield & Everton and back via the Loop Line.
