'Puky offer what's perhaps the ultimate street/touring/ride-to-school bike for younger children: the Crusader 20-3. It uses a 3-speed hub gear with a coaster brake and it's equipped with everything: mudguards, a carrier rack, even dynamo lighting. It's not cheap at £245 but isn't overpriced if your child will be doing a lot of utility cycling.' That's what we say about the Puky Crusader 20-3 in our new book, The CTC Guide to Family Cycling (see page 40).

Thanks to Amba Marketing, Puky's UK distributor, we've got one Puky Crusader 20-3 to give away. It's a cracking bike that's suited for children aged roughly six to nine or from 120cm tall. Despite its accessories it's lighter than many children's bikes because it uses aluminium tubing and avoids cheap and nasty suspension. Growing room is excellent, thanks in part to the low stand-over height, and it's durable enough to be handed down to siblings several times.

Puky also offer a version of Crusader 20-3 with a step-through frame - the Skyride - and a new 24-inch wheel model called the Soulride, with 3 (£300) or 7 (£340) gears. Younger cyclists have lots of properly made bicycles to suit them in the Puky range, and there's a host of tricycles, push-alongs and learner bikes too. The Puky Learner Bike Original gets a thumbs up in The CTC Guide to Family Cycling, as does the Whoosh push-along and the scooter range.
