SIX PANNIERS FROM WWW.BIKEBINS.COM - CHECK 'EM OUT

'We rate the Bike Bin over traditional panniers for day-to-day utility use.' That was Cycle's verdict on the Bike Bin pannier when we reviewed it in the August-September issue last year. Instead of fabric, 'the Bike Bin is a 17-litre rigid box made of 2.5mm polypropylene or polyethylene. The lid is lockable and the bin can also be locked onto the cycle rack itself. Other useful features include eyelets to allow items to be bungeed across the top and a carrying handle and shoulder strap when you want to unclip it and take it with you.

'I used my Bike Bin every day for work to carry spare clothing, food and papers, and my husband used his to carry gardening tools to and from jobs. We both appreciated the lack of rummaging needed to find items: you just open the lid. The Bike Bin is waterproof so there's no need to wrap everything in plastic bags.'

Bike Bins come in black, green, cerise or blue – and now bright yellow. The lid uses stainless steel pinned hinges, while the Bin itself attaches to any carrier rack (with 6-12mm tubing) using Rixen and Kaul's universal attachment system. Each one comes with a 100-key camlock and reflective safety stickers.

Bike Bins usually cost £29.50 each, with all-black Bins just £28.50. UK postage and packing is £6, or £4.50 each for two or more Bins. Thanks to Bikebins, we've got six to give away.
