3 CARRADICE CAMPER LONGFLAP SADDLEBAGS

When we asked CTC members how they travelled light (see p38), one name kept coming up again and again: Carradice. 'Carradice saddlebags, usually attached by an SQR fitting to a seatpost, were the choice for most of our lightweight tipsters,' writes Chris Juden.

'A big saddlebag should be enough for any accommodated tour, and means that almost any kind of bike can be used for touring. The weight is held so close to the saddle that it has little more effect upon handling than a heavier rider might. The "longflap" design allows the bag to expand for extra capacity. Also note the loops by which additional loads can be strapped on top.'

The Camper Longflap is, as its name says, big enough even for camping, with a 24-litre capacity that rivals two front or universal panniers. It's a touring classic because it's so practical and so well made. It's double-stitched from heavy-duty proofed cotton duck, with leather straps and scuff patches designed to withstand hard wear. There are two external pockets, a hi-vis panel, and a mounting strap for an LED light. It can be attached directly to a bike's saddlebag loops but it's even better with a quick-release SQR bracket. The Camper Longflap usually costs £52.95, plus £25.95 for the SQR system, but thanks to Carradice we've got three to give away free - worth over £80 each.
