

The members' page of the CTC website, www.ctc.org.uk, gives access to more than 900 touring routes in the UK and throughout the world: download these routes or add your own. The site includes off-road routes in the UK, information sheets and more.

Routes in the UK include the popular Land's End to John O'Groats pack. This pack has three suggested routes including one off-road route, a general information sheet about cycling the route, a B&B accommodation list and a record sheet to show evidence of your visit. End-to-Enders can also apply for a certificate, badge and T-shirt.

The members' page also includes Cyclists Welcome – details of cyclist-friendly accommodation, refreshments and bike shops throughout the UK. General information pages contain useful guides on a variety of cycling-related topics. Popular sheets include finding a campsite, Channel Tunnel services for cyclists, maps and books, organising a sponsored bike ride, cycle-friendly employers and cycle discount schemes.

A PROTECT A CYCLE BIKE STORE WORTH £550



In a test of a competitor in our Oct/Nov 08 issue, we noted: The Trimetals Bicycle Store is more durable, takes as many bikes, requires less space because of its up-and-over door, and easier to beef up with extra locks and a ground anchor, so I'd recommend that first! We've put our money where our mouth is: editor Dan Joyce bought three!

Trimetals have relaunched their Bicycle Store as the Protect a Cycle, and kindly gave us one for our prize draw. It retains all the features that made the Bicycle Store so good: it's made from PVC-coated galvanized steel panels, which are guaranteed for 25 years against rust; it can be bolted to the ground; the spring-assisted up-and-over door allows easy access to bikes in even small yards; its internal floor area of 180x84cm takes two bikes easily and three with care; it's easy to build; it is weatherproof, maintenance free and fire resistant.

Its already excellent security has been improved further. As well as locking points at the side there are two stainless steel hasps and padlocks for the front, an integral metal base, plus a heavy duty ground anchor with high security cable (complete with padlock). It is the first and only bike store to be awarded the Secure by Design mark – the Police preferred specification. It has also passed the Loss Prevention Certification Board LPS1175.
