CYCLING UK'S 2017 Rides of Way report found that decent waymarking and connected routes were an important consideration for people deciding on where they would go and ride. On Friday 8 June, together with Surrey Hills AONB, Surrey County Council, and funded by the London Marathon Charitable Trust, Cycling UK was proud to launch exactly that with an 80km off-road network that features five family-friendly routes.
