AS CYCLE WENT to press, Cycling UK member Jenny Graham was crossing Canada, on course to break the female record for cycling around the world. She's aiming to finish in 110 days, taking 34 days off the women's record, which would see her at the finish in Berlin in the first week of October. To do this, she's been cycling 180 miles a day, spending 16 hours a day in the saddle. She's riding self-supported, carrying all her own gear, with no vehicles meeting her along the way.
