WITH THE LAUNCH of our new five-year strategy (see previous pages), Cycling UK has ambitious goals. Only 2% of trips in this country are made by bike. We want to change that. We want the proportion of adults who cycle at least once a month rise to 25%. In the longer term, we want 25% of all trips to be made by bike. And we want at least 80% of the population to agree that cycling is safe.

Those are big changes and we'll need help to realise them – not just from other organisations who promote active travel but also from you. You already support our work by being a member. But membership subscriptions are only part of our income; to carry out our work for cycling and for cyclists like you, we rely on grants and donations.

Our Grand Draw raises an extra £20 for every member who buys or sells all the tickets inserted with their issue of Cycle. That could add up to over £100,000! It's money we can use to help make cycling mainstream. It will help us promote and share cycling with others. It will make a lasting difference to people's lives and their communities.

And, of course, it's an opportunity to win some fantastic prizes! The value of all the prizes together is over £11,000 – and they will all be won.

HOW TO ENTER

Two books of tickets, worth £20 in total, are enclosed with this issue of Cycle (each ticket is £1). You could buy them yourself or sell some to family and friends – who knows,

they might win a lovely new bike so they can accompany you on rides!

If you're buying the tickets yourself, just affix the stickers below to the stubs. If your friends and family are buying tickets, they'll need to write their name, address, and telephone number on each stub. Please note: only those aged 16+ can buy a ticket.

HOW TO PAY

You can pay for tickets by cheque or debit/credit card. If you're paying by cheque, make it payable to 'Cycling UK'. If you want to pay by debit or credit card, please fill in the form on the Grand Draw insert included with this issue of Cycle. Due to the way the magazine is mailed, it would be very costly and difficult to make sure some people don't receive raffle tickets. Please do pass on your tickets to friends or colleagues to sell if you don't want them, and accept our apologies for this.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Make sure you that keep your counterfoils (the tickets) and send only your stubs back to Cycling UK.
- Make sure your amount for payment matches the number of tickets you've sold. Two books comes to £20.
- Make sure your details are on each ticket

stub. (They are separated for the draw and blanks are disregarded.)

- Please make sure your tickets are back with us no later than 28th November 2018.
- If you don't want to take part in the draw, you can still support our work with a donation.

FINAL CHECK

Check that your return is correctly addressed, with payment and stubs enclosed, and that it has enough postage for the envelope to get back to us.
