6 Treasurer's Annual Report (circulated with the agenda)

Paul Dawson (Treasurer) reported that:

Club made a surplus of £599, which compares to a loss of £52 last year.

This year's figure includes £550 generated by the sale of the late Peter Brown's bikes and bits, where the committee have approved donation to the charities, Cycling UK Cycle defence fund and Parkinson's UK.

Finances remain in good health, with main income this year coming from the surplus generated by the Tri-vets ride and the £200 per year grant from Cycling UK,

Majority of this year's administration expenditure was for replacement toner cartridges for the laser printer, used for producing the Rides list etc.

Scottish Building Society have decided they were no longer going to provide club type savings accounts. Our account was therefore closed and the funds transferred into our Virgin Money Current account, which also now pays interest.

Total cash assets, held in the Virgin Money Current account, are £7,470.

11 Any Other Business

A Survey of membership

Membership Secretary Steve Brock reported that as of 2 March 2023 there were 345 Cycling UK members registered in TS postcodes. However there were only 34 members registered on the In Case of Emergency (ICE) list when he reviewed and updated it in March 2023. There is therefore a considerable gap between the number of Cycling UK members and regular cyclists. If the club is to continue it is important to determine the level of interest in cycling and provide information that gives an insight into members' needs. This will allow the club to consider changes in the way it reaches out to its local cycling community.

To progress this he had designed a questionnaire in consultation with the Secretary. It was agreed to circulate this to all members via email, Facebook or by (on request) hard copy. Given it s importance to the club's future it was agreed that up to £300 worth of prizes be made available from club funds and topped up (if possible) by Westbrooks cycles. One of the prizes to be a one year membership of Cycling UK.

In the interests of transparency no committee member or Ride Leader would be eligible to won a prize. All other details to be drawn up by Chair in consultation with other committee members and implemented in summer 2023.

B Redesign of club logo

The Secretary reported that the committee had agree to update the club's logo which is believed to date back to 1925. This was likely to be controversial so has been notified to the AGM for any further comment or questions. None were made so the redesign will be progressed in 2023
