Enjoy beautiful Hertfordshire countryside, with four different route options: 18km, 32km, 50km or 70km.

Routes pass through local greens, parks and woods along cycle paths, byways, bridleways, farm tracks, residential streets and quiet rural lanes. There are refreshment stop options on all routes.

Routes are suitable for mountain bikes, gravel bikes and hybrids – whether human or electric powered.

This is a challenge, not a race, and can be ridden either individually or as part of led groups.

- **18 km Route** (40% unpaved, +126 metres climbing)
War Memorial, Symonds Green, Titmore Green, Fishers Green, Norton Green, Cycling Hub.
- **32 km Route** (35% unpaved, +246 metres climbing)
As for 18km Route, plus Hampson Park, Chells Park, Poplars, Roebuck, Wymondley Wood, Cycling Hub.
- **50 km Route** (50% unpaved, +469 metres climbing)
War Memorial, Symonds Green, Langley, Ayot St Lawrence, Sherardspark Wood, Stanborough Lakes, Cole Green Way, Panshanger Park, Bramfield Woods, Raffin Green, Datchworth, Poplars, Cycling Hub.
- **70 km Route** (50% unpaved, +657 metres climbing)
As for 50km Route to Stanborough Lakes, plus Hatfield, Welham Green, Essendon Country Club, Little Berkhamsted, Cole Green Way, Panshanger Park, Bramfield Woods, Raffin Green, Datchworth, Poplars, Cycling Hub.
