

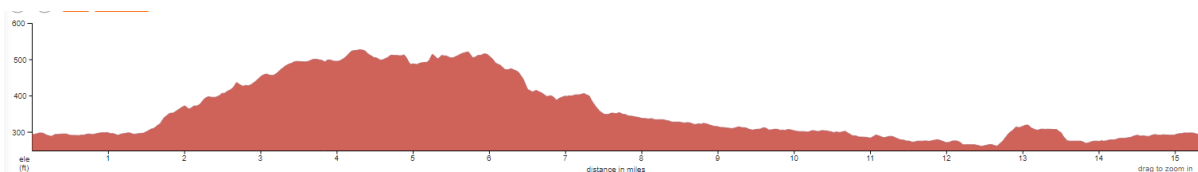
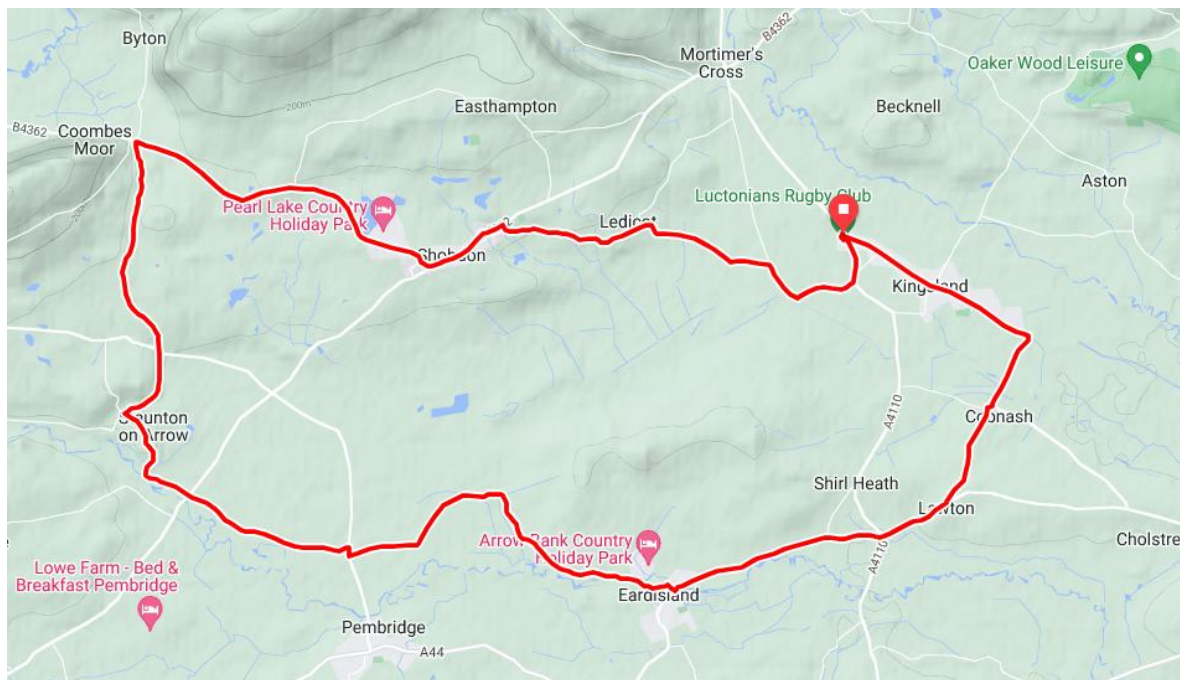


The Luctonians Charity Bike Ride is to commemorate the club's 75th and our cycle groups 10th Anniversary. It is open to cyclists aged 16 and over with a range of experience as well as attracting cycling enthusiasts. The event is fundraising for the Luctonians charity group.

The event offers 3 challenges of a short (25 km) route 1, medium (50 km) routes 1&2 and the big (75 km) routes 1,2&3.

Starting and finishing at Luctonians each route takes you through the wonderful Herefordshire countryside with its iconic black and white villages.

Route 1 - Ledicot, Shobdon, Coomes More, Staunton on Arrow, Eardisland, Cobnash and Kingsland.
