The Greenest way to visit Venues is to join our Cycle-Rides. Spring Fling is Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> May to Monday 29<sup>th</sup> May. These suggested routes could be ridden on any day. You need a copy of the Spring Fling brochure or see the Online Map for detailed studio location info. A phone with the 'What3Words' app loaded would be useful.

Castle Douglas start, 10 studios, about 20 miles - Saturday 27th May 10am - Ride Leader Robin Hogg

**Leave Market Hill car park** down King Street or Queen Street. Turn Left towards Threave Gardens, continue past them to Gelston for **Studios 42,43** Sculpture and Painting.

From centre of Gelston go downhill, then Turn Left back to CD for **Studios 46, 47, 48** Photo-collage and Painting. From the roundabout at the top of King Street, straight on then Left leaving CD past the High School. At cross roads, straight on through Clarebrand. At cross roads after Old Bridge of Urr, straight on to Kirkpatrick Durham for **Studios 53, 54, 55, 56, 57** Metalwork, Prints, Photography, Ceramics and Painting /Prints. **Food/drink in Kirkpatrick Durham Village Hall, or C.D.** 

Return to C.D.

**Dumfries start.** 11 studios. about 40 miles - Sunday 28th May -10am - Ride Leader Tom Hanley

Leave Dfs Whitesands(Devorgila) Cross the Nith to Pleasance Ave - Roberts Crescent, Studio 70, Stained Glass. On to A710 to Shambellie House for Studios 67, 68 Painting Continue on A710 to Studio 66, Drawing, then to Carsethorn for Studio 65, Painting, nature and sea. Return to A710 and continue to Caulkerbush, turn right onto B793 for Studio 62,63, Wood, Wood prints. Return to A710 Sandyhills Studio 61, Painting, on to Colvend Public Hall for Studio 60, Painting. Down to Rockcliffe for Studio 59, Illustrations, Prints. Return to A710 (or Jubilee path to Kippford) Stops in/near Dalbeattie forfood/drink (7 Stanes Brambles cafe, Dalbeattie Garden Centre or Granite Kitchen) Leave Dbt on A711 for Kirkgunzeon Studio 69, Wood, and backto Dfs.
