CYCLISTS RIGHTS.

The local group and CTC/Cycling UK as a whole constantly keep an eye on any new road schemes or alterations to existing roads to ensure that access and use by cyclists is not affected and also to press for better facilities & recognition for cyclists. We try to ensure that the needs of cyclists are taken into consideration along with those of motorists, for instance where new major road schemes are done there should be a safe alternative for cyclists. To this end we take part in consultations with County & District authorities on cyclists' rights both on and offroad.

The local group is also affiliated to SUSTRANS, the Railway Path & Cycle Route Construction Charity, which builds and gives advice on cycle paths and routes all around the country.


The East Sussex CTC local group exists to organise rides and special events for Cycling UK/CTC members in the East Sussex Area. However, anyone may come along to try out Club riding or take part in one of our events, we simply ask that after 3 or 4 rides, if you are not already a member, then you join the CTC/Cycling UK, since membership gives you third party liability insurance and free legal aid for cycle related matters - we hope you never need it, but it's good to know it's there!



The local group consists of people from a wide range of backgrounds but with a common interest -CYCLING. We are a touring Club, not a racing one, and everyone is welcome whatever their ability or age - though we do ask younger riders

(under 16) to bring an adult along. We offer the opportunity to ride in company, to explore some of the less well known parts of our area, and to enable you to meet others with an interest in cycling & the outdoors.

The local group has 4 Sub-groups; 2 catering for different areas of the county, 1 with occasional Saturday rides and a Midweek Group which attracts members from all areas.
